Additionally, we have been operating internally as a green company for many years through our recycling efforts, green cleaning programs, alternative transportation incentives for employees, and our annual holiday tree planting in which Kirksey plants trees for our clients in lieu of holiday gifts. Begun in 1987, this program has allowed the planting of almost 7,000 trees throughout Houston.
